


COVID-19 Vaccination — Upload your COVID-19 records via the secure Occupational Health Services Portal. You must be logged into a UCSF network or sign on to Pulse Secure VPN. Find out how to access VPN here: <a href="https://it.ucsf.edu/service/vpn">https://it.ucsf.edu/service/vpn</a> . You may also email your documentation to vaccineresponsibleoffice@ucsf.edu. The OHS portal is the central repository for the entire UCSF community COVID-19 vaccination data and used for compliance and reporting purposes.  WHO-EUL vaccines may also meet the requirements.
